The Utah Pride Center is thrilled to welcome Utah Furs to the 2023 Utah Pride Parade, and we are so excited you have chosen to join the celebration! After three years, the parade is back with over 15,000 participants and an expected 100,000 spectators! This guide will help direct you to the right place on Sunday morning and prepare you for what to expect in the staging area.

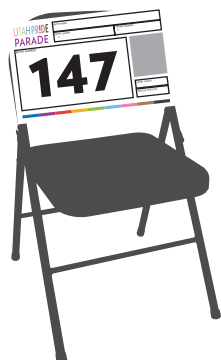
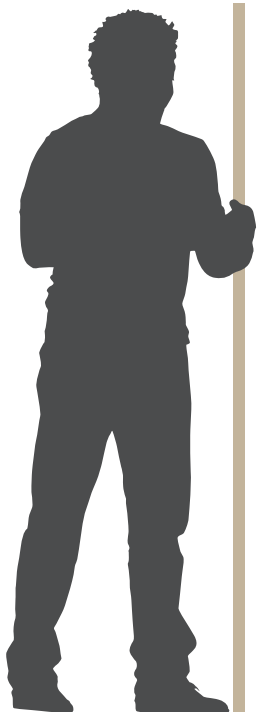
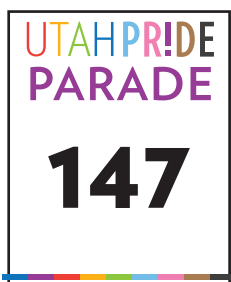
ARRIVAL & ASSEMBLY:

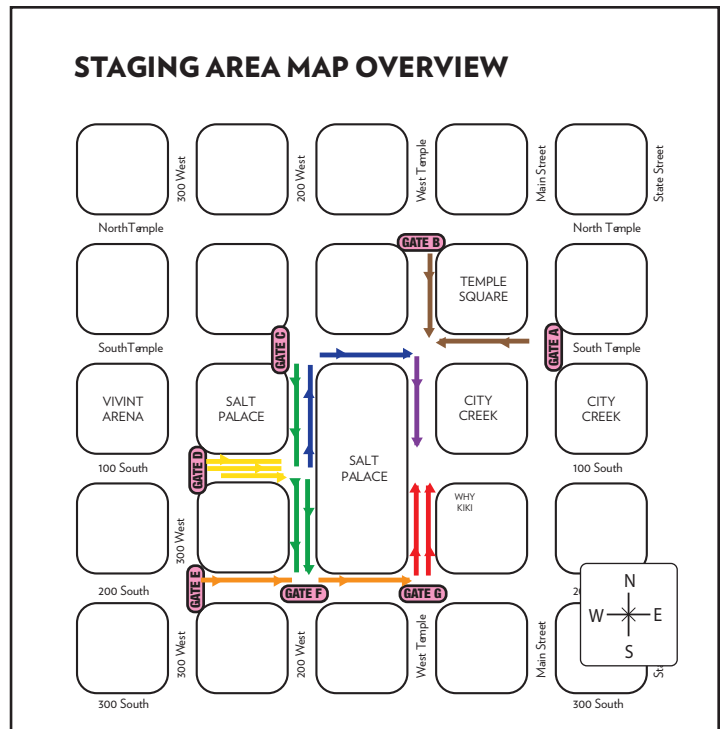
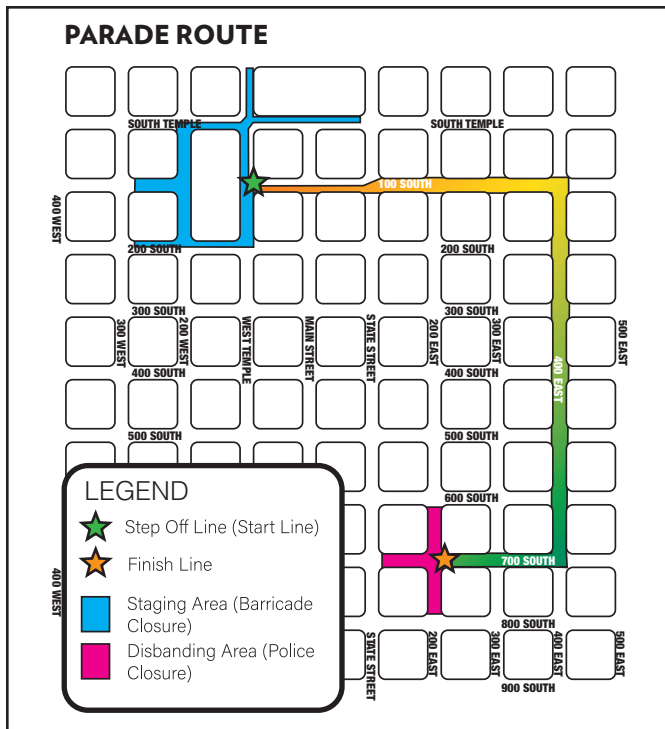
Make sure to give yourself plenty of time to get to the staging area. Utah Furs is entry number 147. Your call time is 10:40 AM Sunday morning. At call time, please make your way to your designated staging area on the Yellow Line, shown on the following page. Look for a tall sign with the number 147 on it, held by your entry leader, Kristin Goc-ong. You may also find your number on a chair in the same area.

After you arrive, check-in with your entry leader, and get your official participant sticker. Each participant will need a sticker with their number on it to indicate they are part of your group.

There is a lot that goes into getting ready for your step off, and we would hate for you to miss the parade. Your arrival at 10:40 AM is critical to getting your group on the parade route on time. Once assembled, follow directions from your entry leader to make your way to the step-off line. Your anticipated step-off time is 11:52 AM.

We know the wait time can feel long, and we greatly appreciate your patience with the process. There are many moving pieces and people, and your cooperation and punctuality are key components to having a smooth morning.





THE PARADE:

The parade route is 13 blocks long and about two miles. We anticipate you will finish the parade between 12:37 PM and 12:51 PM. Please be sure to bring water, snacks, sunscreen, and anything else to help you get to the end of the parade. We advise everyone to check the weather and plan accordingly. The parade is held, rain or shine.

PARKING:

The question of the day: Where will I park? The Utah Pride Parade does not provide or contract any parking for the event. Participants are encouraged to ride share or take public transit. The Temple Square Trax Station is located right on the side of our staging area. Pay to park lots can be found in a few places surrounding the parade staging area:

RULES & REGULATIONS:

- Candy, Flyers, Novelty items or "Swag" of any kind is prohibited from being distributed in any way during the parade. Reported entry's may face fines and expulsion from future parades.
- No Fire or water can be used in your entry. Water for drinking purposes, however, is allowed and highly encouraged.
- No animals are allowed in the Utah Pride Parade unless they are riding in a vehicle and leashed. The pavement is incredibly hot and poses a danger to the animal, as well as to the spectators in the parade.
- No Nudity or Obscenity is permitted by Utah State and Salt Lake City codes and ordinances.
- No Drugs & Alcohol will be allowed, as we are on public streets.
- No solicitation on the parade route.
- No third-party representation is allowed inside your entry. Marching in a group you are not authorized to march with is grounds for expulsion from the parade.
- Bring a smile, get ready to have an unforgettable pride!
